Activities

As a Family Child Care Provider you must provide:

- active and quiet play
- indoor and outdoor play
- rest or sleep
- meals and snacks
- safe toys and play equipment
- creative materials
- dramatic play for pre-schoolers (dress up, puppets, books, play phones and dishes)
- visual and small muscle development (mobiles, blocks, rattles, puzzles, sorting toys)
- auditory development (records, musical instruments)
- creative expression (clay, paint, crayons, paper, scissors)
- large muscle development (swings, balls, bicycles, large boxes and wagons)
- majority of time out of crib, playpen, walkers, swings
- minimal use of television
